# The 350 Martyrs, Disciples of Saint Maron Feast, July 31



In the year 451, the Council of Chalcedon decreed that there is both a human and a divine nature in the person of Christ – two natures in one person.

In the year 517, a large group of Maronite monks from the monastery of Saint Maron was travelling to the monastery of Saint Simon the Stylite, near Aleppo, when they were ambushed by a group that opposed the Council's teachings. 350 monks were killed but many were able to escape. Alexander, the Superior of the monastery of Saint Maron and the superiors of the neighboring monasteries, wrote to Pope Hormisdas informing him of the events that had taken place.

The Pope responded on February 10, 518, and encouraged them to persevere in the Catholic faith and praised the faith of the martyred monks. That letter still exists in the Vatican Archives.

Let us pray today, that like the 350 Martyrs we are always obedient to the teachings of the Church.
